<p>Food and Drink</p> <p>Harry's favourite snacks are raisins and fruit.</p> <p>Harry has Juice (cordial), any flavour but must be very very dilute.</p> <p>Sleep</p> <p>For Harry to be able to sleep if he is tired.</p> <p>Harry must have his dummy if he does want to sleep or if he is really really crying.</p>	<p>If you offer Harry a snack he will eat it if he's hungry.</p> <p>Harry will drink his juice from a cup.</p> <p>Harry really has no routine with sleep just if he gets tired to let him sleep.</p> <p>Take Harry's Dummy out of his mouth as SOON as Harry is asleep, so that he does not choke and the dummy does not damage his teeth.</p>

<p>Nappy</p> <p>Harry must have regular nappy checks and must always be clean</p>	<p>At the moment he does have a slight rash on his bottom due to teething, use sudocreme or zinc and castor oil to soothe this</p>	
<p>Leaving and Collecting Harry from Nursery</p> <p>Harry likes a kiss and cuddles off his mum when she leaves him and collects him from nursery.</p>	<p>Harry is a confident little boy and it is best for him if he knows that mum is leaving, with a cuddle and a kiss.</p>	

What is important to Harry

If Harry is upset and crying....

Harry must have his own space if he is upset in order for him to become settled again

If he becomes really upset or starts to scream he must have his dummy

What we need to know to be successful in supporting Harry

First check to make sure that Harry is not in pain, tired or hungry.

If Harry does cry for any reason it is best that he is given some space to calm down, doesn't like to be made a fuss of when he gets upset

When Harry is settled ask him for his dummy back.
